



Table Lamp 3149-3 "Moulin Rouge"

On special requests we gladly execute special designs. For a Cabaret Theatre in Vienna called Moulin Rouge (not to be confused with the Moulin Rouge in Paris-France) we were asked to create a table lamp resembling the figurative logo of the theatre: a windmill in brass and crystal.

The basic structure of this item is a lean brass frame which is decorated with thousands of individual crystal beads. The sails of the mill were even to be turned.

Behind the crystal, 3 light bulbs give the lighting for this witty object.
